

Participation requirements – Terms and Conditions

In the eventuality, that a registered participant is unable to attend the conference, the participant must inform the JMEC in writing by email.

Cancelling conditions:

Up to 31.01.2017	CHF 100.00	processing fee	will be charged
From 01.02.up to 30.03.2017	50%		of the total cost will be charged
From 01.04.up to 25.05.2017	100%		of the total cost will be charged

Liabilities: The organiser (JMEC) is not liable for any losses, accidents or damage on people or objects, no matter what the cause. All participants, and people accompanying, participate in the conference at their own risk and their own responsibility. The participant must be aware that no compensation can be claimed from the JMEC if the implementation of the conference would be cancelled or altered due to unexpected political circumstances (i.e. strike) or due to economic or climatic reasons. Equally, no compensation can be claimed in the event of the cancellation of speakers or changes to the program and schedule. By registering, the participant accepts these terms and conditions. The participant also accepts to be added to the organisers' database which will be published.

Film, videos, and photographs: Taking films, videos and photographs during the conference is permitted. It is possible that some pictures taken by the organisers or by the participants during the Conference will be shown on the JMEC website after the event. By registering for the conference the participant automatically agrees that the photos and videos can be publicly used without any charges.
